

# Monumental Inscriptions - St Michael and All Angels', Barton Turf

## Details

The details are currently being checked for accuracy and completeness - records which have been checked have their numbers shown in **bold**.

The reference numbers used in the 1883 survey are printed in square brackets, e.g. [PC12].

There is one inscription on the outside of the South porch, see row 07/01.

Sarah NORRIS widow of Anthony NORRIS, died July 26<sup>th</sup> 1787 aged 70.

Inscription:

In the same Vault which contains the Bodies/ of her Husband and Son/ are deposited the Remains of SARAH/ the widow of ANTHONY NORRIS Esquire,/ who after discharging all the Duties of Wife, Parent,/ and Friend, with Affection and Tenderness;/ departed this Life, in the full Confidence of a Christian;/ July 26<sup>th</sup>, 1787. Aged 70./ Deprived of an only Child, eminent for his Virtues and Abilities,/ her orphan Nieces,/ Dame SUSANNA DURRANT, and SARAH CUSTANCE,/ became the Objects of her Care/ and Bounty:/ Who, conscious of the Respect/ due to the Memory of/ their benevolent Relation,/ have caused this Monument/ to be erected.

Arms: The same as those of Anthony Norris.

In/ this Vault/ are deposited the Remains of /ANTHONY NORRIS, Esq.,/ who,/ Born Nov<sup>r</sup>. 11<sup>th</sup> 1711, Died June 14<sup>th</sup> 1786./ And also those of/ JOHN NORRIS his only Child./ He was born 28<sup>th</sup> Jan<sup>ry</sup>. 1737-8, and died 19<sup>th</sup> March 1762./ Reader./ When thou art informed that the Son had a comprehensive Mind,/ enriched with pure Religion, abstruse Knowledge, classical/ Learning, and every elegant Acquirement, thy first Regret/ for the Feelings of his Parents will be absorbed in lamenting/ the Loss which the Community sustained by being thus/ early deprived of such an exalted Character./ To this Decree of Heaven the Father submitted/ with a truly pious Resignation./ Admire then the greatness of his Soul,/ And Know/ that He lived not for himself, but for the Public./ His eminent Abilities being constantly employed as a Christian/ in the exemplary Discharge of every religious Duty:/ as a Magistrate, in dispensing Justice with Mercy, as a Scholar,/ in digesting the Productions of classic Ages and of modern/ Times; as an Antiquary and Historian, in collecting the various /Revolutions of Families and Possessions in this his native County./ Ever anxious for the Edification of others:/ his Faculties at last became exhausted,/ and his Mind ceased to be active, ere he ceased to be./ SARAH his Relict,/ though now deprived of the endearing Names of Wife and Mother,/ yet still retaining the grateful Remembrance/ of those tender Connexions,/ in humble Confidence of a future Union,/ consecrates this Monument to the beloved Memory/ of an affectionate Husband/ and a dutiful Son.

Arms: Quarterly: 1<sup>st</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>, quarterly, Argent and gules; in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> a fret over the 1<sup>st</sup>; over all a fess azure, *Norris*; 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>, Sable, on a cross couped and pierced five pellets, *Graile*; *impaling* Or, an eagle displayed gules, charged on his breast with an estoil of the field, *Custance*.

Translation:

Here lies John Idewyn one time Vicar of this Church who gave for the use of the said Church one whole Vestment in red velvet and who died the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1497. On whose soul Lord have mercy. Amen.

Note: John Idewyn was Vicar of Barton Church from 1456–1497

Note: Colonel Venner's daughter Elizabeth married John Potter, in or around 1709, who was Professor of Divinity in Oxford, afterwards Bishop of Oxford, and lastly, Archbishop of Canterbury and Chaplain to the Queen.
